ARTS

Arts Programme (£1.4 million)

Community at Heart funded an arts team to deliver a range of activities including regular low-cost classes, public art projects (for example Barton Hill Mural) events and festivals.



Arts Projects

The arts team worked with other projects to bring art into this community for example art in the gardens of the blocks, Barton Hill Primary School and Children's Centre art project and art in the Dings and Lilla Park.

Animation Festival

The arts team organise an annual festival, which brings high quality arts into the area and attracts around 200 people from the whole of Bristol to come to Barton Hill.



Bristol Community Radio (£138,500)

Community at Heart funded Radio 19, a community run radio station. This was so successful that the group won the licence to broadcast community radio across Bristol and became BCfm. BCfm is going from strength to strength and provides volunteer placements and training to hundreds of local people every year.

Grass Roots Community Newspaper (£122,839)

Community at Heart funded a highly successful community newspaper, which was published for the area and run by local people. The project provided training opportunities for local people in journalism skills and won a citywide award for best community newspaper. In 2007 local residents took over control of the paper and formed their own independent company.



Soundin' Out

Community at Heart funded a music project for young people giving them the opportunity to write and record their own music.
